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With reference to the above, I am by direction to inform that conditional affiliation is now granted to New Degree College namely, Govt.Degree College, Sabbavaram, Visakhapatnam Dist for the academic year 2008-2009 to offer the following Courses/Combinations with intake & medium of instructions as noted below initially, subject to fulfillment of following deficiencies immediately, as pointed out by the Inspection Commission along with other conditions/requirements as per the Andhra University Statutes, Rules & Regulations, and also the conditions/norms of the Govt. & Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Govt.of AP, from time to time.

The Status of the College is RURAL - CO-EDUCATION.

The Management of the College shall abide and be bound by the provisions of Andhra University Act (now the A.P. Universities Act 1991). Statutes, Regulations, Standing Orders of the Executive Council that are now in force and that may be laid down from time to time in future.



In addition to the above, the Principal is directed to adhere and implement the following also:


1. The staff should be recruited separately for this purpose with Ph.D., NET/SLET qualification in the particular subject/area.
2. The Principal of the College is required to submit the list of UG/PG staff with photographs and Bio-Data immediately.
3. There should be a clear demarcation between UG and PG staff. The salary and other emoluments should commensurate with the revised UGC scales.
4. There should be a separate building, laboratory and library for the PG Courses. There should not be any link between UG and PG Courses.
5. A well-qualified Director must be appointed for PG Courses exclusively.
6. There should be a good play ground and recreation facilities. It is also desirable to provide hostel facilities at least for a minimum number of boys and girls separately.

The Principals of New Govt. Degree Colleges should take the responsibility of fulfilling deficiencies if any as pointed out by the Inspection Commission and submit proof of evidence (like Photographs, bills, indents, etc.) substantiating that they have fulfilled the same before the classes commence, to the CDC. The University has every right to impose fine/cancel affiliation if any of the colleges violate the rules and regulations or if they do not fulfill the requirements as mentioned above.

The College should strictly follow the Academic Calendar of the University from time to time. An extract of the important provisions of Chapter-XII of Andhra University Code Volume-I may be collected from C.I Section, A.U. for your guidance.
